County Code Administrator inspection fee \$50.00

IL EPA law & Jersey County Ordinance have a no burning of debris of any kind other than yard waste \$1,500.00 fine (IEPA)

County may assess fees for Code Administrator's time, mileage and processing fee

Penalty: any person, firm, or corporation who violates any portion of the International Property Code Maintenance shall upon conviction in Jersey Co. Circuit Court be subject to a fine of up to \$750.00 for each violation. Each day that such violation exists shall constitute a separate offense.

Fines*

Failure to obtain a residential permit prior to construction	\$250.00 plus court costs
Failure to obtain a commercial permit prior to construction	\$500.00 plus court costs
Failure to notify the Code Administrator of a required inspection	\$100.00 plus court costs
