

NOTICE TO ALL CONTRACTORS:

CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION REQUIRED

(An Ordinance Regulating Contractors, adopted July 10, 2019)

Effective July 10, 2019, all contractors who is engaged in or having an obligation to do work for compensation for the citizens of Jersey County located in the **declared disaster area** are required to register with the Jersey County Code Administrator and obtain an application for Contractor Registration and obtain a permit and placard (valid during the period in which the area is declared a disaster by the Jersey County ESDA Coordinator).

Requirements for obtaining a registration are as follows:

- ✓ Complete the application for Contractor Registration and pay \$25.00;
- ✓ Provide proof of a valid current certificate of insurance or bond;
- ✓ Provide satisfactory licenses as required by profession, roofers, plumbers, electricians;
- ✓ Provide a listing and copies of driver's licenses or other identification for all individuals employed by or with you who are working in the disaster area; and
- ✓ Provide a listing of all vehicles, make, model, and license number that will be present in the disaster area.

A color coded placard will be issued to those registered and shall be placed in the window of the vehicle(s) that were registered with the Jersey County Code Administrator. Any person who violates any provision of the Ordinance or fails to comply with any of the requirements shall be guilty of an offense punishable by a fine of \$500 for first offense up to \$2,500 for the third offense.

*Applicants are subject to background check per Illinois State Attorney General.
